God's mission is to restore all humanity back to himself. Adam and Eve lost that precious relationship they had with God because of their disobedience; but it was restored again

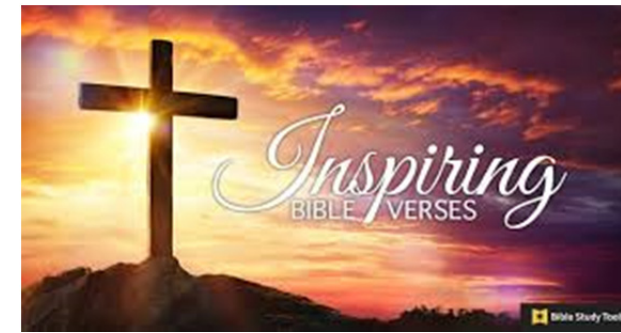
through Jesus Christ because of his death and resurrection for our sin. God calls us to join him in the mission of reaching out to those who do not know Christ by sharing the Gospel with them.
