### **SYNOPSIS OF THE ARMENIAN SERMON**

(John 10:1-18)

In Isaiah 53:6 says, “All we like sheep have gone astray.” In this parable, humans are compared to sheep and Christ is the Shepherd. Humans are like sheep – lost in sin and in need of guidance.

In verses 1-6, Christ uses this to illustrate the way to heaven. **Christ is the great Shepherd** and He opens the door to God’s salvation for those who accept His leading. Sinners do not follow Christ because they do not know His voice.

In verses 7-15, **Christ is the gate.** He is the only way of salvation. All who come to Christ will be saved, and He will turn none away. His blood cleanses us from all sin.

In verses 16-18, **the world needs Christ.** Christians should not be content with their own salvation – they should feel compelled to reach the lost because Christ died for all.

Christ came into the world to teach humans the way to heaven. He is the way, and by His teaching and example, He will lead us. **In this New Year may we all live obedient lives to our Good Shepherd.**
