Synopsis of the Armenian Message

(Ephesians 2:11-22)

We live in a divided world – black/white, Arab/Jew, rich/poor. In the first century the basic distinction was Jew/Gentile. For that reason some Jewish Christians had trouble accepting Gentile converts. In this passage the Apostle Paul shows how God brought unity to all the divisions through Christ. (11-12), **In the past**, the Greeks, who called those outside of their cities – pagans, and the Jews, who called every one else – Gentiles, were divided and despised each other. (13-18), **In the present**, Jesus has broken the wall of hatred that separated both groups. All people – Jew and Gentile – can come to God through Jesus. In His death He not only brought harmony between man and God, but also between man and his fellowman. (19-22), **in the new reality**, Christ brings us all together and builds up into Him.

Friends, only Christ's blood can save us. Only He can break down every wall that exists today (ethnic, social, political) and bring true unity.
