Synopsis of Armenian Sermon

In Psalm 90, Moses contrasts the brevity of human life with God's eternity. In verse 1-6, he says that God has always existed; He is eternal, infinite, and unchanging. From *everlasting to everlasting He is God*. In contrast humans are like grass that springs fresh in the morning and withers and fades in the evening. In verses 7-11, he recognizes that human mortality is a result of God's wrath against sin (Genesis chapters 2&3). Human's lives are short and full of trouble and sorrow. In verses 12-17, Moses prays for God's mercy. He says, "*Teach us to number our days aright.*" Wise are those who recognize how short life is and make sure that they are living according to God's will. He ends the psalm by asking God to look in favor over His people.

Friends, since life is short, redeem the time and buy up the opportunities. Yet remember that Jesus has purchased for us life and immortality.
