Synopsis of the Armenian Message

While Paul is in Antioch, Luke shifts our attention back to Ephesus. After Paul had left Ephesus an eloquent preacher by the name of Apollos had arrived there. Luke tells us that Apollos was a “learned man, with a thorough knowledge of the [OT] Scriptures.” Even though his preaching was powerful, and he had been instructed about Jesus’ life and teaching, yet it seems that he was somewhat deficient in his knowledge of the Christian faith. When Aquila and Priscilla heard him speak they recognized that he needed some more instruction, so they lovingly invited him to their home and explained to him the way of God more accurately. To His credit, Apollos also had a teachable spirit that allowed him to be taught by a tentmaker and his wife. “It is a mark of a godly man to show that he is teachable in this way (Proverbs 9:9)” (SU). As a result of this, Apollos was encouraged and commanded through a letter to go to Corinth where he had a very effective ministry.

How about you friends? Do you have a humble and teachable spirit? Pray that God will you give such a spirit.
