#### SYNOPSIS OF THE ARMENIAN SERMON

Jesus’ nature has been and will always be the same: He is Loving, righteous, faithful, and good. We can rest assured that He will never change. He loves all His creation. **Here are three focal points that show us that Jesus is forever the same:**

2. Jesus wants us to build our life on His Word: Jesus is the foundation of our life. We need to grow and mature in His powerful Word that can transform our lives to look like His, full of love and righteousness; by spending time with Him in prayer and reading His Word.
3. Jesus wants us to have a close relationship with Him: Christian living is not just dos and don’ts, it is a relationship that we experience with the risen Christ. He came to restore the relationship that was broken in the Garden of Eden due to the disobedience of Adam and Eve. He wants to bring the full glory of His presence as was intended when He created us.
