SYNOPSIS OF THE ARMENIAN SERMON

The Apostle Paul remind us of the glory God has filled us with through His Spirit that He poured on us. God has lavished His love on us without condition because He has made a new and everlasting love covenant through His Son Jesus Christ. He wants us to be filled by His Holy Spirit so that we might produce a life that can impact others by sharing the good news with them.

Here are three points of the benefits of living in the Spirit of God:

1. The Hope of Glory In the Spirit: We should never forget how precious we are in the sight of God. He has called us His children. We are heirs with Christ with all the blessings that we enjoy now and eternity to come through the Holy Spirit who dwells in us.

2. Suffering for Christ Produces Perseverance: And perseverance produces character, and character hope, a living hope for what is to come. When we allow God’s Spirit to mold us into the character of Christ, we become mature and ready to serve in any capacity he calls us for.

3. The Holy Spirit wants to use us in a mighty way: God called us into His kingdom to enjoy the many blessings we have received, but he also wants us to share His goodness with others. The scripture says ‘freely you have received, freely give.’ Pray that the Lord will use you in a mighty way for His kingdom.
