### SYNOPSIS OF THE ARMENIAN SERMON

The Apostle Paul encourages us to be ‘strong in the Lord and in His mighty power.’ The days are evil, we cannot fall asleep spiritually. The devil does not rest, he is constantly after the believers with his schemes to draw them away from the Lord. We need to be on our guard not to let him set foot on us, instead we need to resist him in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ.

#### Here are three points about remaining Strong in the Lord:

- 1. We must remain strong in the Lord:** As soldiers of Christ, we need to constantly be on guard against the devils’ schemes, who wants to devour the believers. We must fight him back with the Spirit and Word of God.
- 2. We must put the full armor of God:** We cannot live mediocre lives; we won’t last for long in our battle with the devil and his demons. We need
- 3. Suffering for the name means we are doing God’s will:** Peter says if we are reviled for the name of Jesus, then the Spirit of God is resting upon us. It is better to please God with suffering than to seek comfort and not live in God’s will.
